- Come in Wednesday morning 9am until 10.30am to get extra help for your subject/s.
- Form a study group to help each other.
- Attend homework club classes Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday after school.
Homework club is in the library from 3.00pm – 5.30pm on Monday and Tuesday and 3.30pm – 5.30pm Wednesday.
- Be organised and use course outlines to know when assessment tasks are happening.
- Attend assessment preparation and revision classes.
